

Movements of Lee in 2011

05 January 2011: South to Blackwater Reservoir area

Lee flew south-west to the forests NW of Blackwater Reservoir on New Year's Day and was still in that area on night of 3rd/4th January.



09 January 2011: Moved to Glen Lethnot

Lee moved back to Glen Clova on 6th December, then to Glen Lethnot on afternoon of 7th and was still there morning of 8th December.

16 January 2011: Moving back and forth in Angus

Lee went back south to the Glen Lethnot area on 10th January and flew back north over Glen Esk on 15th, when at 4pm he was approaching Hound Hill, and later roosted the night west of the Cairn O'Mount road. Between 10th and 16th January he was in an area of 140 square km.



17 January 2011: To Glentnar

Yesterday afternoon, 16th, Lee flew to Glen Tanar and was in the main glen at 4pm.

22 January 2011: North to Inchroy

Lee was in Glentnar until 10am on 17th, then there were no more GPS locations but non-GPS locations came in for early on 20th January when he was at the north end of Loch Builg.



26 January 2011: Probably back in the Glen Esk region

Poor quality signals on 24th suggested he was back in the Angus Glens.

30 January 2011: Back at Invermark

Only non GPS signals which showed him to the east of Invermark on 28th and 29th January.

05 February 2011: No change

Poor signals but still in the Invermark to Glentarnar area.

14 February 2011: No news

Lee was alive on 5th February, but the signals from the north Angus glens were poor quality and the battery had not been fully charged, due to poor weather. But there were no signals for 9th or 13th February which is a bit worrying. Hope the sun comes out and charges the battery soon. Next transmission due on 17th, if nothing then will start to get more concerned.

28 February 2011: No news

Lee's transmitter was scheduled to switch to two-hourly schedule on 25th, and I was hoping that might 'kick in' renewed transmissions. No signals suggest that Lee is either dead or the transmitter has failed.
