

# Movements of Angus 33 in 2011

## 21 October 2011: Big flight out and back to Strathspey

On 15th October, Angus 33 was at Gairnshiel, and then roosted overnight north of Ballater. Next day 33 flew NW and at 11am was at the RSPB Abernethy Forest Reserve. Keith Duncan was eagle watching there that day and saw two young eagles (including this satellite tagged one) along with the pair of adults, which had not bred in 2011. 33 Turned back and at 1pm was flying south to the east of Ben a’Bhuird. Roosted there overnight and was at Spittal of Glensheeo 18th, just east of Braemar on 18th and 19th, and then back to the natal home range. A strong initial exploration.



## 05 December 2011: To Ladder Hills and Cabrach

33 had moved to the Ladder Hills on 28th November, north of Bellabeg on 2nd December and at The Buck on Dec 4th. The transmitter is failing to get full sunlight in the short days so mainly non GPS data.

### 11 December 2011: Strathdon to Deeside

GPS data not collected due to weather conditions, but was near Corgarff at 11.16am on 4th December and on the hill just east of Braemar at 1.27pm on 8th December.

**15 December 2011: Remained in Strathdon/Glenlivet and Cabrach areas**

33 remained in the The Ladder Hills east to Cabrach areas to 14th December, but transmissions were non GPS.

**19 December 2011: No change**

Glenlivet south to Ben Newe on 14th and in Strathdon on 16th December.
